Description

Introduction to the gross anatomy of the various organ systems of head, neck and trunk regions of the human body. Emphasis on functional anatomy. Laboratory component includes exploration of the human body through cadaveric dissections, imaging and other materials.

- Prerequisites: BIOL 112 (or CEGEP equivalent), PHGY 209 and PHGY 210
