Description

Further opportunities, beyond those provided in the core courses of the low-intermediate level, for students to increase their English language vocabulary and develop their reading skills. The course is designed to help students develop strategies for extrapolating meaning from context at both the sentence and paragraph level. Students will develop techniques for using sentence level and paragraph level clues to understand word meaning, sentence meaning, and paragraph meaning.

- Corequisite(s): CEEN 202, or CEEN 211, or CEEN 212
- Prerequisite: CEGl 106 or permission of the Director.
- Restriction: Only open to students in the Certificate of Proficiency - English for Professional Communication
