- Prerequisites: GPHL 301, GPHL 303
- Restriction(s): Open to students in a Population and Global Health undergraduate program.
- The host organization requires the instructor's approval. Students are responsible for paying for their travel costs which include food and lodging. However travel grants will be sought to help offset the costs.
