Land-based practices and Indigenous literature. Participation is based on the values of Skén'nen (peace), Kahsatsténhsera (united strength), Ka'nikonhrí:io (good mind).

- Prerequisites: Required INDG 200, INDG 401 is recommended but not required.
- Restrictions: Open to students in the Indigenous Studies Program or with permission of the instructor
- This is an intensive summer field course.
