## Description

Principles and practical methods of abstracting and indexing.

Topics include pre- and post-coordinate indexing, concept analysis, vocabulary control, construction and evaluation of thesauri and of indexes for books, periodicals, and series; emphasis on the role of the computer in indexing.

- Not open to students who have taken GLIS 656.
