Description

- Prerequisite: Department placement test, instructor approval.
- Students in this level have studied Arabic for the equivalent of four semesters or have been exposed, for a short period of time, to Arabic and one of its dialects in a native speaking milieu. Students are encouraged to give ideas and express opinions through discussions and role playing activities.
