

# NUR2 649. NEONATOLOGY INTERNSHIP 1.

## Description

This internship is designed to provide the student with the experience needed to practice as a neonatal nurse practitioner caring for the complex neonatal patient. It will allow the neonatal nurse practitioner student the opportunity to apply theoretical knowledge to the care of the neonate in multiple settings, with focus on practice in Level III neonatal unit. Emphasis will be on the transfer of theoretical knowledge and the individualization of patient care. Family dynamics will be assessed and are considered integral to the management plan. The student will be expected to demonstrate leadership behaviors in the clinical setting.

- Restriction(s): Not open to students who have taken NUR2 650D1.
- Open only to students in the Graduate Diploma in Neonatal Nurse Practitioner.
- A fee of \$21.39 for one name pin will be charged based on registration in this course.
