- Restrictions: Only open to students in the M.Sc.(Applied) in Human Nutrition; Non-Thesis Dietetics Credentialing program.
- Students must register for both NUTR 629D1 and NUTR 629D2.
- No credit will be given for this course unless both NUTR 629D1 and NUTR 629D2 are successfully completed in consecutive terms
- NUTR 629D1 and NUTR 629D2 together are equivalent to NUTR 629.
