Description

Diseases and pest management of cannabis grown under greenhouse and field settings. A systemic approach to descriptions of pests and diseases accompanied by an overview of biological, natural and management solutions to pests and cannabis diseases. Details on products and application methods that are in compliance with Health Canada. Practical laboratory sessions to identify various disease symptoms on cannabis plants and to recommend solutions.

- Prerequisite: PLNT 470
- Restriction: Only open to students enrolled in the Diploma in Commercial Cannabis
- All pre-requisites must be passed with a minimum grade of B-
