

# NON-EVALUATED WORK FOR CONTINUING STUDIES STUDENTS

If you are attending a course that has an evaluation process (such as an examination or other criteria), you may choose not to be evaluated. To do this, you must complete the required form at [mcgill.ca/continuingstudies/scs-current-students/scs-student-records/scs-non-evaluation](http://mcgill.ca/continuingstudies/scs-current-students/scs-student-records/scs-non-evaluation) prior to the start of the third lecture. Submitting this request will result in a grade of NE (No Evaluation) on your academic record. Under no circumstances will a course with a grade of NE count toward a certificate, diploma, or degree program. Note that only courses administered by Continuing Studies can have a grade of NE.
